

# **DOCUMENT OF CONSTITUTION AND STATUTE**

## **FEDERATION**

### ***EURO EDUCATION FEDERATION(E.E.F.) – CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE FOR HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT, EDUCATIONAL, ARTISTIC, CULTURAL, SPORTS AND TECHNOLOGY***

**ART. 1.** It is, according to Law no. 246/2005 and under this Statute, **FEDERATION EURO EDUCATION FEDERATION (E.E.F.) - CENTRE FOR HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT, EDUCATIONAL, ARTISTIC, CULTURAL, SPORTS AND TECHNOLOGY**

**ART. 2.** **FEDERATION EURO EDUCATION FEDERATION (E.E.F.) - CENTRE FOR HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT, EDUCATIONAL, ARTISTIC, CULTURAL, SPORTS AND TECHNOLOGY** is a private legal person with patrimonial purpose, independent and autonomous, organized according to Law no. 246/2005.

<b>ART. 3.</b>	<b>FEDERATION EURO EDUCATION FEDERATION (E.E.F.)</b> is a private Romanian legal person, with proof of name availability name reserved by the number 119 274 of 17.12.2012 issued by the Ministry of Justice - Department of Communication and Public Relations.
<b>ART. 4.</b>	<b>4.1 FEDERATION EURO EDUCATION FEDERATION (E.E.F.)</b> is a non-governmental federation, non-profit, independent, international, political autonomy and acting in public benefit and / or mutual prerogatives of its members.
<b>ART. 5.</b>	<p style="background-color: #d9e1f2; margin: 0;"><b>DURATION AND HEADQUARTERS</b></p> <p><b>5.1 FEDERATION EURO EDUCATION FEDERATION (E.E.F.)</b> it was established for an indefinite period of time;</p> <p><b>5.2</b> The headquarters is in Str. Constantin Brancoveanu, nr. 69, bl. 47A, ap. 32, Craiova, Dolj, 200 232, ROMANIA.</p>
<b>ART. 6. OPENING/DISSOLUTION BRANCHES</b>	
<p>6.1 The Federation may open branches in other cities or counties in the country or abroad covering European space, and depending on international open branches;</p> <p>6.2 Branches are territorial divisions with or without legal personality, consisting of at least 3 members, opened by the decision of the Senate General (General Assembly) or the Supreme Council. For establishing a branch the consent of at least 51% of members / contributors of the senate general. Branches constituted 6.3 runs on the organization and operation regulations (ROF), code of ethics and professional conduct and status of the federation;</p> <p>6.4 The management / administration branches is provided by a government that can be aided by two vice maximum. The governor may have an economic and a legal adviser - in this case the advisors should have specialized studies (economics or law). Governing bodies of the branch are part of the federation's executive bodies. Branches can not control his own body, and they are assessed by the inspectorate or the inspection of the federation (auditor or auditing committee).</p> <p>6.5 Branches can have their own bank accounts, own stamps, own property, with Senate approval and can manage general structures / bodies etc. territorial federation;</p> <p>6.6 Branches can carry out activities to achieve the objectives and goals of the federation, that the conditions described in Article 6.5, without the consent of the Senate general, but it is necessary to have the consent of 50% of the members of the branch, provided that they have an obligation the governing bodies of the federation submit activity reports in January (for July to December) and in July (for January to June) and the income and expenses; Liability for any disputes with third branch governor returns federation is exempted from any legal liability or economic branch; Branch can not conclude financial contracts on behalf of the federation;</p> <p>6.7 The Governor, Vice branches and advisors are employees of the federation, their remuneration is made only from the own funds of the subsidiary, with the Romanian legislation and this statute; Membership fees 6.8 branch, established under this Statute shall be deposited in the bank account of the federation, even if the situation described in Article 6.5. General Senate may approve the use of such amounts, at a maximum 50% of the total contribution branch branches for carrying out the projects. The earmarking of contributions from members or branches in donations, legacies or sponsorship can not be used for salary expenses of its employees.</p> <p>6.9 Income derived branch (membership fees are not considered to be income of the branch, but the income of the Federation) shall be submitted either in own bank account (if any), or for the account federation, which are used within the law and the statutes of the federation, in order to achieve the goal and objectives of the federation, the Governor, with the approval of the branch members. If those revenues are deposited in the bank account of the federation governor will need to use their legal representative's approval of the federation; and whether they will be deposited in their account the governor can decide how to use them, with the approval of at least 50% of the branch members, answering, according to Romanian legislation amounts used. The amounts of sponsorships, donations or legacies can not be used for salary expenses, unless this is specified explicitly in the act of sponsorship, donation or legacy and only up to 10% of the total.</p> <p>6.10 Revenues branches are made of</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• interest and dividends from investments in legal terms;</li> <li>• revenues from direct economic activities;</li> <li>• Donations, sponsorships or legacies;</li> <li>• resources from the state budget or local budgets or other public budgets;</li> <li>• other revenues provided by law;</li> </ul> <p>6.11 Branch can buy movable and immovable property, with the consent of the governor and 50% of federation members, but the alienation of these goods will not be possible without the consent of 90% of members of the Senate General and only in special occasions, observing the procedures / rules / regulations</p>	

and by-laws of the federation; The acquisition of movable and immovable property is based on an auction / market analysis in which it will take into account price / quality ratio and goods that exceed 5,000 euros, the legal representative can ask the governor a report of motivation, the need to purchase, reasons for choosing the supplier, which will include as an annex, documentation auction / market analysis, prepared in accordance with regulations / rules / procedures and legal federation;

6.12 General Senate may decide, after consulting activity reports and documents concerning revenues and expenditures, dissolving branches, in accordance with Article 6.13;

6.13 Dissolution of branches may be decided whether for one calendar year has not earned an income greater than a minimum gross salary per economy has not conducted any activities to fulfill the purpose and objectives of the federation and / or if its assets does not exceed the 5 minimum gross salary per economy;

6.14 Dissolution of a branch can be done in the following cases:

- by general senate, if it has no members;
- by general senate, that the activities do not pursue the purpose and objectives of the federation;
- by general senate, that the activities of branch is unlawful or contrary to public policy;

6.15 Movable / immovable assets of the branch dissolved the federation will enter the patrimony;

## **Art. 7**

### **SETTING/DISSOLUTION ORGANISMS (research institutes, educational institutions, training centers, agencies, etc. throughout Europe and internationally)**

7.1 Can be based Federation / initiate the establishment of independent and autonomous body, alone or in collaboration with institutions, bodies, agencies etc. national or international government to fulfill its purpose and objectives; Regardless of how the foundation will be strictly observed and the provisions contained in this Statute;

7.2 These bodies are structures of the federation of governing bodies, execution and internal control and have a distinct heritage of the federation. They can acquire legal personality and based on status federation / own Rules of Operation and Organization (OBR) own and Code of Business Conduct and Ethics own approved by the Senate generally within Romanian law and international and this Statute. For federation bodies will obtain prior administrative authorization if the legislation so provides.

7.3 ROF body shall include the name and information on the legal basis of the establishment and functioning body, a succinct presentation of business; organizational chart; Partial organizational chart of the main components of organizational structure (if necessary); Detailed presentations of key organizational characteristics (specific and individual goals, tasks, authority and responsibilities of collective leadership and individual); Detailed description of the departments and functions incorporated, for first presenting the objectives and tasks. Descriptions organizational compartments is made according to their organizational succession, these modules are grouped appropriately senior subordination of socio-economic system in question and other relevant information for the work of the body. Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct establishes the fundamental principles and ethical norms of staff bodies and include general code of ethics and professional structures and mechanisms for implementing the code, final provisions (if applicable), providing for sanctions for breach thereof, within under Romanian law and international law.

7.4 federation bodies are made up of staff based curriculum vitae, cover letter, interview (presentation / CV detailing the relevant activities, etc.) and test / exam professional skills and knowledge. Staffing can be helped in carrying out its activities, volunteer federation.

7.5 In view of the staffing of the bodies federation, constitute a committee of founding president, or in his absence by the legal representative of the federation, at least two specialists in the professional field for which the contest is organized, we can get a specialist in human resources adviser economic and legal counsel; The Commission may also be represented by foreign persons federation, respecting the principle of moral and professional values (recommend as committee members hold at least the title of associate professor at a university accredited by national or international);

7.6 Employees, including management bodies and execution are employed through an employment contract for a definite period of maximum four-year contract that can be renewed only after a further examination or contest and shall be subject to the provisions of annual assessment described in section 7.7.

7.7 The personnel of the bodies will be reviewed annually by a committee consisting of at least two specialists in place of those evaluated, a legal adviser and economic adviser (recommended evaluators are external to the body which includes the evaluated) in month from January to February in this respect is mandatory testing of professional competence (practical test and tests) and an analysis of the work carried out (it will focus on tangible results of work on the projects' impact on the target group directly and indirectly and in society). If the employee fails to obtain at least note 7 (multiple choice) and a very good rating or Excellent (practical test / interview) legal representative and the committee decided to penalties. If this assessment will get an average grade between 5 and 6.99 and will be organized well enough or a test of its powers over 3 months after initial

testing. If staff will not get any second test, the minimum note 7 (multiple choice) and graded Very Good or Excellent (practical test) legal representative and the evaluation committee decided to impose financial penalties thereof - the reduction of wages 15 - 30%. The next annual review in this case, unless you obtain the minimum note 7 (grid test / interview) and a very good rating or Excellent (practical test) legal representative and the Commission shall termination. If the employee annual testing obtain a mark of less than 5 qualification and insufficient legal representative and the Commission shall termination. If the employee get a higher grade 9 and grade excellent legal representative and the Commission may decide to increase 5-25% of wages, if the body, which is engaged financially afford this increase;

Note: The procedure for hiring and evaluation of staff will be detailed in specific documents, approved by the governing bodies of the federation, the federation's compliance status.

7.8 The provisions regarding the staff of this Statute shall be passed explicitly in the employment of the employee as well as special provisions.

7.9 The management / administration bodies is provided by a Director / President, etc., can be helped by a maximum of two deputy directors / vice etc. Governing bodies of the body are part of the federation's executive bodies. Bodies can not control one's own body, and they are assessed by the inspectorate or the inspection of the federation (auditor or auditing committee).

7.10 The bodies may have their own bank accounts, own stamps, own patrimony with Senate approval General;

7.11 Bodies of activities to achieve the objectives and goals of the federation without the consent of the Senate generally indicate that the obligation to submit the governing bodies of the Federation Activity Reports in January (for July to December) and in July (January to June) and the income and expenses; Liability for any disputes with third parties bodies designated rests his legal representative, the federation is exempted from any legal or economic liability of the body;

7.12 Bodies can be financially supported by the federation, up to a maximum of 25% of the federation;

7.13 Income bodies are made of:

- interest amounts available under the law;
- income from services rendered;
- Donations, sponsorships or legacies;
- resources from the state budget or local budgets;
- other revenues provided by law

7.14 Dissolution and liquidation of bodies shall be subject to Chapter IX, the L 246/2005 and Romanian legislation, their assets, if any, being taken by the federation

## **Art. 8**

### **SETTING/DISSOLUTION STRUCTURES OF THE RELATED UNITS OF THE FEDERATION (departments, directorates, clubs etc.)**

8.1 Federation to fulfill the purpose and objectives runs on organizational structures and establish related establishments (clubs, centers leisure, pensions, etc.), with compliance; For related units of the federation or of the structures will be obtained prior administrative authorization if the legislation so provides.

8.2 Organisational structures are subordinated legal representative and board - appointed Governing Council, serving to streamline the fulfillment of the purpose and objectives of the federation. Related units of the Federation and branches are organized as unincorporated structures consisting of at least 3 members with regulation / self organization and functioning status, which are designed to help achieve the goals and objectives of the federation. They can be set up in cooperation with state institutions, in which case the consent of the legal representative of the partner institution.

8.3 The organizational basis of the organization and functioning (ROF), code of ethics and professional conduct and status of the federation; Auxiliary units operate under the regulation / self organization and operation status, developed within the law and this statute and approved by the legal representative of the federation and of the partner institutions.

8.4 The leadership / management related organizational structures and units is provided by a director / manager / president etc., can be helped by a maximum of two Deputy Vice ... etc .. Governing bodies of their part of the federation's executive bodies .

8.5 The organizational structures and related units of the federation can work with staff to which the provisions of art. 7.7 and 7.8 and / or provisions relating to the staff of the federation.

**ART. 9** The Federation may establish collaborative links with similar organizations or enter into unions or federations, other institutions and legal entities or individuals in the country and abroad, to fulfill its purpose, noting that through such actions federation he can not lose any independence / autonomy nor legal status.

## **ART. 10**

## GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

**10.1** Members of **EURO EDUCATION FEDERATION (E.E.F.)** wish to associate in order to promote / develop civic values, democracy and the rule of law in the fields of education, training and research; continuing education and human resources development; information and communications technology; Youth and Sports; cultural, religious and historical; family, health and social protection; tourism, regional development and environmental protection.

**10.2** Objectives of constitution of **EURO EDUCATION FEDERATION (E.E.F.)** are:

- 10.1.8. initiation, implementation and development of education and training;
- 10.1.9. monitoring and evaluation of activities of state institutions, the implementation of the national and international policies in the fields of interest of the federation and to the development and proposal of corrective measures regarding the policies and activities of the institutions involved in education, training and research;
- 10.1.10. monitoring and evaluating the implementation of legal provisions by the institutions involved in its areas of interest;
- 10.1.11. monitoring and evaluating the way in which the recruitment, selection, promotion, criterion Romanian competence and compliance personnel from education, training and research;
- 10.1.12. participation in international programs and projects, Community and bilateral field;
- 10.1.13. promote and protect the rights and freedoms of education personnel training and scientific research (teaching staff, auxiliary teaching staff, etc.);
- 10.1.14. achieving and promoting modern training strategies, education, training and research;
- 10.1.15. representation and counseling, psychological and legal staff education, training and research (with the authorities and public institutions - ministry inspector, legal institutions, etc.) by promoting a system of values and attitudes based on democratic principles, ethical respect for fundamental human rights, trust and understanding;
- 10.1.16. supporting the development of the education system, training and scientific research system based on democratic principles and transparency;
- 10.1.17. conduct activities of any kind of any kind, on the system of education, training and scientific research and its human resources, in compliance with national and international law;

#### 10.2. Continuous training and development of human resources

- 10.2.1 developing studies on lifelong diagnosis and prognosis;
- 10.2.2 ensure the quality and diversity training programs and resources involved;
- 10.2.3 training and human resource development in all areas, including education and health;
- 10.2.4 identifying, mobilizing the resources needed to support and enhance training system;

### ART. 11

#### ACTIVITIES

• **Art.1.** Political associations are groups of citizens political voting, participating freely and exercise their political formation, fulfilling a public mission guaranteed by the Constitution. They are legal entities of public law;

• **Art.2.** Through their work, political associations to the values and interests of national, European or international, political pluralism, contribute to forming public opinion, participate with candidates in elections and the establishment of public authorities and stimulate citizens' participation in the polls, according to the law;

• **Article 3.** (1) can function as political associations only political groups constituted according to law, and which fights for national or international sovereignty, independence and unity of states or federation, territorial integrity, the rule of law and the principles of constitutional democracy;

(2) Any political associations which, by statute, programs, propaganda or other activities it organizes, violates the provisions of various national constitutions and international;

(3) It is forbidden political associations affiliation with organizations from abroad, if the affiliate violates the values provided in the constitutions of law of those States;

(4) political associations may not organize military or paramilitary activities and any other activities prohibited by law;

• **Art.4.** (1) political associations are organized and function criterion counties.

(2) Any establishment of structures of political associations by the criterion of work and the pursuit of political activity among economic or public institutions;

(3) development of political activities at the level of undertakings or public institutions is allowed, with their consent, only in the election campaign, according to the law.

(4) In the territorial organizations of political associations can organize their structures to deal with specific problems of a certain social or professional;

• **Art.5.** (1) Each political association must have a full name, abbreviation and its permanent mark. The full name and abridged permanent sign must be clearly distinguished from those of previously registered associations, being forbidden to use the same graphical symbols, whatever geometric shape they are framed.

(2) Para. (1) shall apply to political alliances, as appropriate;

(3) the full and abbreviated name and permanent sign can not reproduce or combine the national or international symbols, other countries, international bodies or religious cults. Exceptions are political associations that are members of international political organizations, which can use the badge that organization as such or in a specific combination;

(4) permanent sign can be changed at least six months before the election, by the competent organs of the party, according to statute and in compliance with the Constitution;

• **Art.6.** Political associations may be members of citizens who, according to the Constitution, vote

• **Art.7.** Entry rights associations:

(1) A citizen may not belong simultaneously in two or more associations or political alliances;

(2) The registration of a person in another political association is the right of association whose resignation was previously member;

(3) Upon enrolling in a political association any person is required to declare in writing on their own responsibility whether or not a member of another political associations;

(4) Members of national minorities organizations that nominate candidates in elections and be part of a political association, with the right to apply the law;

(5) No one may be compelled to belong or not to be part of a political association.

(6) Acquisition or loss of membership of a political association does not create privileges or limitations on the exercise of civil rights;

• **Art.8.** Status of political association necessarily include:

a) the full and abbreviated name;

b) description of permanent signs;

c) permanent mark as color and black and white graphics in the Annex;

d) headquarters;

e) express mention of pursuing political objectives only;

f) the rights and duties of members;

g) penalties and procedures by which they can be applied to members;

h) the procedure for election of executive bodies and their competences;

i) the competence of the general meeting of members or their delegates;

j) bodies empowered to candidates in local, parliamentary and presidential elections;

- k) to propose reorganization competent body to decide the party or association in a political alliance or other forms of association;
- l) conditions in the outgoing;
- m) the administration of assets and funding sources established in law;
- n) the body representing the party in relations with public authorities and third parties;
- o) terms stipulated as mandatory in this Law;
- **Art.9.** (1) Associations political subdivisions of territorial organization, according to the administrative organization of the country that have the minimum number of members specified by statute;  
(2) Local authorities can represent the political party to third parties at the local level can open bank accounts and are responsible for their management;
  - **Art.10.** (1) general assembly and executive body, regardless of the name they have in each association status are compulsorily leading to political association and its regional organizations. Territorial Management shall be elected for a determined period, prescribed by statute;  
(2) Statute may provide other bodies with attributions made explicit;
  - **Art.11.** (1) The general assembly of political association members or their delegates at the national level, is the supreme decision of political association. Board meeting takes place at least every 4 years;  
(2) Assembly delegates are elected by secret ballot territorial organizations. Their number is determined in relation to the number of members. The procedures for designating and delegating them to be stipulated in the statute;
  - **Art.12.** (1) For the settlement of disputes between members of political associations and management organizations, or between the association, the arbitration shall be created at its territorial associations and organizations;  
(2) The members of the committee are elected for a maximum period of four years;  
(3) The arbitration is organized and operates according to a regulation approved by the statutory body which should provide parties the right to opinion and the right to defend and equitable decision procedures;
  - **Art.13.** (1) The authorized bodies of political association members decide receipt, as provided by statute, following written applications submitted by the applicant;  
(2) Members have the right to resign from the association at any time with immediate effect;  
(3) the acquisition and loss of membership of a political association is subject only to the internal jurisdiction of the respective association, according to the statutes of the association;
  - **Art.14.** (1) The decisions of political association and of its territorial organizations shall be adopted by a majority stipulated in the statute;  
(2) selection of the management association leaderships political and territorial organizations shall be by secret ballot;  
(3) The statute must provide each member's right to political initiative and the possibility examination within an organized framework;
  - **Art.15.** (1) To register a political association shall be submitted by the federation following documents:
    - a) registration application, signed by the chief executive of political association and at least 3 founding members, who will be summoned to appear;
    - b) the status of the association, drafted according to Art. 10;
    - c) association program;
    - d) memorandum, together with a list of supporting signatures of the founding members;
    - e) a statement regarding the establishment and Heritage Association;
    - f) proof of bank account opening;
  - **Art.16.** Association acquires legal policy from the date of the final and irrevocable court decision on the admission application for registration;
  - **Art.17.** (1) Political Association may participate on an association protocol, constituting a political alliance;  
(2) In the protocol associating political associations in a political alliance should indicate the name in full and abbreviated name of political alliance and the political associations components, permanent sign of the alliance, the Alliance's objectives, organization and decision makers ;  
(3) The provisions of art. 5;  
(4) shall apply accordingly;  
(5) The permanent symbol of political alliance may be one of its own or can be picked up from one political associations components;
  - **Art.18.** (1) legally constituted political associations can proceed with reorganization;  
(2) Reorganization may consist merger by absorption or merger or the division, total or partial;
  - **Art.18.** (1) merging two or more legally constituted associations is done by approving the merger

protocol decision by the supreme bodies of each association, mentioned in art. 14, joint meeting them;

(2) In the merger protocol will be mentioned explicitly in the modalities for the transfer of amounts, assets and contracts held by the merged parties and the procedure for securing the continuity of political association members seniority in merging political associations;

(3) Protocol is set to merge its character: by absorption or merger;

• **Art.18.** (1) In merging by absorption, one political associations retains legal personality, subrogandu the rights and obligations acquired outgoing associations, including by aggregating their subsidies. In the merger protocol will specify the association retains legal personality, with consequent keeping full name, abbreviated name, a permanent sign and electoral and political program;

(2) The Protocol consolidation and, if necessary, changes to the bylaws that retains its legal status is issued within 10 days of the adoption, ROF tribunal of the federation, following the procedure;

(3) absorbed political associations will be removed from the Register of Political Associations (RAP);

• **Art.18.** An association outgoing policy: a) dissolution by judgment of the Constitutional Court of the Federation, for violating the abovementioned provisions of the Constitution of the Federation;

b) dissolution by judgment of the Tribunal;

c) self-dissolution, decided by the competent bodies stipulated in the statute;

d) reorganization in the situations mentioned in the articles mentioned above;

k) recovery under Romanian law and human rights, property belonging to Greek traditional communities in Romania until March 1945: churches, churches, schools, theaters, cinemas and other assets therein for various purposes;

l) dynamic activity of the management bodies of the Union and its subordinated communities in the interests of all its members;

m) promoting Greek language and learning for all members of the Federation, particularly for young people;

n) conducting of cultural and language Olympics Greek national and local level;

a) Greek clubs organizing, equipping them with adequate equipment and materials, organizing sports activities, tourism etc. at home and abroad;

p) publishing publications - newspapers, magazines, books and others that reflect the history, traditions and customs of the Greeks presence in Romania, historical continuity and the

business model of traditional communities and other communities organized after 1990;

q) to support parishes that Greek and Greek churches providing religious services in Greek and Romanian language at the request of parishioners or others that require;

r) development of statistics on the social situation of members and initiation of adequate social assistance programs, especially for members with economic and social problems.

s) promoting and cultivating the Greek and Romanian national cultural traditions;

\* Informatica - which aims:

a) development projects software, electronic hardware and internal or external funding through sponsorships or grants;

b) organizing training courses, trainings, competitions, Olympiads;

c) development of individual projects or in collaboration with other public or private organizations or institutions in the country or abroad;

a) the establishment of companies, subsidiaries, associates or freelancer groups that contribute to the development of useful software applications NGO;

\* Establishment of music ensembles, dance, ballet, dance or theater and film;

\* Donations of food and clothing for the elderly abandoned

\* Partial or full sponsorship of surgery for children with physical impairments

\* Donations of educational materials to schools (school supplies, computers etc.)

**ART. 12.**

**MEMBERS**

**12.1 EURO EDUCATION FEDERATION (E.E.F.)** it is composed of:

- a) Founding members - individuals who have decided to establish **EURO EDUCATION FEDERATION (EEF)**, persons benefiting from certain rights under this statute and legislation;
- b) Members of the associates (voting) - individuals that joined the federation after obtaining its legal personality and be attracted sponsorship / funding minium 10% of the gross minimum wage / year, or paid the annual contribution set The governing bodies of the Federation;
- c) associate members (non-voting) - individuals that joined the federation after obtaining its legal personality, but not within the financial provisions of the point B;
- d) Honorary members (with consultative vote, if only honorary members) - natural or legal persons who through their work have been noted in the area of interest of the federation;
- e) volunteer collaborators (without voting rights - and if they are not members of the federation) - individuals carrying out activities based on a voluntary agreement;
- f) Staffing, according to labor law and the provisions of this Statute;

**12.2** May become members of **EURO EDUCATION FEDERATION (EEF)**

• persons who submit a written adhesion, accompanied by a letter and a curriculum vitae motivation, people who undertake to respect the status of the federation and the code of ethics and professional conduct, developed by founders or by Senators general. Membership is acquired through approval by the Senate adhesion or legal representative of the General Federation / Supreme Council;

• NGOs, institutions and other organizations interested in promoting the goals and objectives of the federation.

**12.3** Honorary Membership is awarded by the Senate generally individuals who have made an important contribution to the federation or activity that had a special activity in areas of interest of the federation. Honorary members may be members of the federation, in compliance with art. 12.2;

**12.4** Exclusion of a member is made by the general Senate. Membership ceases after a withdrawal request from the federation, exclusion, death or termination of legal personality.

**12.5** Members who retire or are excluded have no right over the property of the federation.

**12.6** Application for admission to the Federation EURO EDUCATION Federation (EEF) - CENTRE FOR HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT, educational, artistic, cultural, sports and technology are submitted in writing at police headquarters or sent electronically on federal mail federation(

euro.education.federation@gmail.com) filling out the form downloaded from the website Federation (www.euroeducation.ro), followed governing bodies (Board) to decide thereof within 10 days the filing date.

## **ART. 13.**

### **RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF MEMBERS**

Members **EURO EDUCATION FEDERATION (EEF)** have the following rights and obligations:

#### **13.1 FOUNDING MEMBERS:**

- **rights:**

- Founding Members may take any decision to achieve the goal and objectives of the federation, within the Romanian legislation and international not need the express consent of the other founders or the agreement of the management, execution and control of the federation, but it is recommended to consult their especially after the period of organization and development of the Federation (first five years);
- Of the first paragraph may benefit chairmen / coordinators and county, between the organization and development of the Federation (first 5 years of existence), provided that the measures, activities etc. taken to not conflict with the provisions and principles of the federation or the supreme council representative;
- To elect / appoint bodies, execution and control of the federation;
- To hire staff from the laws in force;
- Approve / exclude / sack etc. members;
- To establish branch organizations, organizational structures and related units, in compliance with art. 6, 7 and 8;
- To set up counseling centers, economic and legal areas of interest of the federation;
- To set up centers, clubs etc. social assistance Leisure, and hosting of children and women victims of domestic violence;
- To set up centers, clubs etc. Leisure;
- To set up publishing houses, printing etc;
- To set up educational institutions (kindergartens, schools, universities etc.);
- To establish driving schools (auto, etc.);
- To set up, organize, evaluate and lead departments, directorates, agencies, institutes, centers, other bodies in the Federation or with its own legal personality;
- Take decisions to achieve the aim and objectives of the federation in accordance with Romanian law and international - to achieve this as the founders did not require the consent of the management, execution and control of the federation, but it is required to federation members on decisions will was to be taken;

- **obligations:**

- To participate in activities organized by the federation;
- Develop code of ethics and professional conduct of members of the federation;
- Develop, to bodies established regulations, methodologies, codes of ethics and professional conduct, etc.
- Seek to promote the interests and respect for the status of the federation;
- Founding members may not be removed / excluded etc. unless they are convicted for acts that violate the principles promoted by the Federation;

#### **13.2 MEMBERS ASSOCIATIVES:**

- **rights:**

- Propose and elect the governing bodies, execution or control - according to the statutes of the federation;
- To vote if they are contributing members - they have paid the membership fee established by the governing bodies;
- To be elected to the governing bodies, execution or control - if they are required by statute;
- To make proposals for activities, projects, programs etc .;
- Initiate, organize and implement activities, projects, programs etc. under the tutelage of the Federation and the President of the federation and / or the Senate general;
- Take advantage of a federation or federation partners for free or with a discount of 5-50%, while full payment of dues;
- Propose and vote for the membership fee amount Association;
- Have access, on request, information concerning the activity of the federation;
- Make any proposal for analysis and approval by the governing bodies, to achieve the goals and objectives of the Federation

- **obligations:**

- To participate in activities organized by the federation;
- To comply with the Statute and Rules of organization and operation of the code of ethics and professional conduct and decisions of governing bodies;
- To work for the prestige of the federation;

- Identify sources of funding to meet the goals of the federation;
- Not to make public statements that contradict decisions affecting the federation or its general interests;
- To contribute by lawful means to achieve goals and objectives of the federation;
- Not to take actions which, by their nature, may harm the interests of the Federation.
- To regularly set aside a certain amount that will be determined later - fee is not mandatory, but it leads to restriction paying a deliberative vote, his vote with only a consultative role and cancellation facilities offered contributing members;

Note: Non-compliance can lead to exclusion from exclusion among Federation members will be decided by the board / general senate.

### 13.3. HONORARY MEMBERS:

- rights:

- Support in all steps and activities for seeking support to enhance its image and reputation, nationally and internationally, approaches and activities that do not contradict the interests of the federation;
- Have the opportunity to be awarded / financial remunerated for their contribution to increasing the image and prestige of the federation;

- obligations:

- Not to take actions which, by their nature, can damage the image or reputation of the federation;

Note: Non-compliance may result in the withdrawal of honorary membership.

### 13.4. VOLUNTEERS:

- rights and obligations:

- Voluntary set out in the contract;

13.4.1 volunteer is required to submit a curriculum vitae and a letter of intent. The appointee Federation / branch / bodies / organizational structures and related units will communicate within 15 days arguing decision in case of refusal;

13.4.2 volunteers can be reimbursed certain expenses and may receive incentive awards for work done;

### 13.5 STAFFING:

- rights and obligations:

- Are provided in the employment contract and job description;

Staffing is classified based on the curriculum vitae, letter of intent, an interview and a competition / testing skills and vocational skills - procedures described in Articles 7.4-7.9 of the present statute;

- Employment will have priority federation members and volunteers, with a length of at least one year;

13.6 Rights and obligations Federation members will be described in detail in ROF and Code of Business Conduct and Ethics of the Federation, prepared in accordance with art. 7.3 of this statute;

## ART. 14.

### STRUCTURE:

**14.1.** Governing bodies of EURO EDUCATION Federation (EEF) are:

- The Supreme Council - made up of members / president / founding regional presidents;
- The General Assembly - General Description and Senate - consists of all active members, with voting rights (paying dues or contributed to the development and sustinerea federation);

**14.2.** EURO executive bodies EDUCATION Federation (EEF) are:

- The Board called Governing Council;
- Government / Managers / etc., leaders of organizations, departments etc. federation

**14.3** Body control EURO EDUCATION Federation (EEF) is the auditor or auditing commission Federation can be called inspectorate.

**14.4** The representative body of EURO EDUCATION Federation (EEF) is the founding president or, failing that, the President, Vice President or his designee general senate. Regionally federation may be represented by regional president founder.

Note: Founding regional presidents may have their own bank accounts, own stamps, own property and take decisions at the regional level to develop federation. They will serve as a branch of the Federation and the provisions of art. 6 less art. 6.2 and 6.13.

**14.5** The Federation will be organized on the basis of historical regions led / coordinated and monitored by a regional president, who will be assisted by vice county 2-5 (depending on the districts allocated to each region). Regions will function as branches of the federation, in compliance with art. 6 exception art. 6.2 and 6.13. Regional presidents and county election procedures will be described in detail in the ROF and relevant documents federation and in compliance with this statute and European/Romanian legislation.

## ART. 15.

### Governing bodies of the federation:

**15.1 The Supreme Council** is the governing body of the federation first formed by founding members, which is dissolved after the death of the last founding member or written consent of the last two founding members;

**15.2 General Senate** is the governing body of the federation, which is composed of all members of the federation

## ART. 16.

### Meetings of the Supreme Council / Senate General

**Supreme Council / Senate General** meets twice a year in ordinary session - in January and July, and in extraordinary session whenever needed. Supreme Council / Senate General is legally constituted if they participate physically or through modern means of communication (video conference discussion groups, virtual conferences etc.) at least half plus one of the federation members (paying members).

If, at the ordinary meeting does not meet the statutory number of members, the meeting will be reconvened by default more than seven days of the date stated in the convocation, when it will be considered legally constituted with any number of members present and extraordinary meeting is legally constituted regardless of the number of members convened.

## ART. 17.

### Convocation Supreme Council / Senate General

**17.1 The Supreme Council/Senate General** ordinary meeting shall be convened by a founding member, president, governor or council at least 1/3 of the members of the association, at least one week prior to the meeting by written notice (letter classic e-mail , newsgroups etc.). The notice shall include mandatory identification and contact details of the / those who convened the meeting, date, place (if any), how the hearing (physical or virtual, through modern means of communication) agenda. Where the meeting will take place virtually (group chat, video conferencing, etc.) accepting electronic signatures (handwritten signature scanned and sent organizers of the meeting), organizers of the obligation to communicate in writing (letter, it is even - mail, discussion groups, etc.) the minutes of the meeting.

**17.2 The Supreme Council/General Senate** is convened in extraordinary session by a founding member, president, governor or council at least 1/2 of the members of the association, at least one day prior to the meeting by written notice (letter classic e-mail , newsgroups etc.). The notice shall include mandatory identification and contact details of the / those who convened the meeting, date, place (if any), how the hearing (physical or virtual, through modern means of communication) agenda. Where the meeting will take place virtually (group chat, video conferencing, etc.) accepting electronic signatures (handwritten signature scanned and sent organizers of the meeting), organizers of the obligation to communicate in writing (letter, it is even - mail, discussion groups, etc.) the minutes of the meeting.

**17.3** The decisions of the Supreme Council / Senate General taken under the statute law and are binding on all members of the federation, even if it took part in the meeting or voted against.

**17.4** The Supreme Council / Senate General is headed by a founding member, President, a Vice-President, Secretary General or by another member of the Governing Council.

**17.5** Decisions are taken by vote (secretly or openly) by a vote of at least half plus one of those present. If the meeting is held by means of modern communications is required to validate the vote, to communicate in writing (letter Classic, e-mail, discussion groups, etc.) organizers. The document will include the identification, decision which has been voted as voting and electronic signature;

Founding members can not comply with these provisions, making them part of the Supreme Council of the Federation.

## ART. 18.

### The duties of the Supreme Council / Senate General

- a) approve the strategy and overall objectives of the federation;
- b) approval of the income and expenses and annual financial statements;
- c) election and recall of Governor Council, the President and Governors / Managers etc. bodies / departments etc. Federation;
- d) elect and revoke the censor or censor committee;
- e) establishment of branches;
- f) amend the Constitution and the statutes of the federation;
- g) determining the amount of membership fees;
- h) determine the emoluments of the President, Vice-Presidents, governing council members, governors / managers etc, auditors and staff;

i) dissolution and liquidation of the Federation; disposition of assets remaining after liquidation; General Assembly decisions are taken by simple majority, each member having the right to one vote. In case of parity, president of the federation decides.  
Founding members can not comply with these provisions, they have responsibilities to achieve the objectives pursued unlimited federation.

#### **ART. 19.**

##### **The bodies of the federation execution:**

**19.1 Governing Council** is the executive body of **EURO EDUCATION Federation (EEF)** and is composed of an odd number of members, at least 3 as follows:

- President of the Federation;
- Governors / managers etc. Federation bodies and departments;
- Auditor or representatives revision commission (maximum 3 members);
- Representatives Senate General (up to 6 members);

**19.2 Government / Manager** etc. - Part of the executive body of the Federation, heads of branches, bodies, departments, etc. federation subordinates Governing Council;

**Governing Council / Governor** etc. is responsible for the overall management of the Federation, achieve its goals and objectives.

**Note:** the management or execution can not include people who have been convicted, who made political police have held senior guidance and control through the support of political or other circumstances, without supporting competitions/exams before dealing those functions that do not have a good reputation, in accordance with European/Romanian law.

#### **ART.**

##### **Governing Board meetings**

**20.**

The board of directors meets in ordinary session once a month, and in extraordinary session whenever necessary.

#### **ART. 21.**

##### **Powers Governing Council / Governor**

**21.1 Governing Council** ensure the execution of judgments of the Supreme Council / Senate General

In the exercise of its Governing Council:

- a) submit to the Supreme Council / Senate General annual activity report, the budget of revenues and expenses, annual financial statement, the budget of revenues and expenses and project federation programs;
- b) legal agreements and on behalf of the federation, without infringing federation and status;
- c) proposes the Supreme Council / Senate General personnel policy of the federation;
- d) authorize any person, including persons who are not a member of the federation, to legal acts in the name and on behalf of the federation or to perform any other functions provided in statute or established by the Supreme Council / Senate General.
- e) propose Supreme Council / Senate General Rules of organization and functioning;
- f) propose Supreme Council / Senate General organizational structure, duties and responsibilities of personnel federation compartments / departments etc .;
- g) perform any other duties established by the Supreme Council / Senate General

**Note:** The Governing Council has a maximum term of four years.

##### **21.2 Guvernatorul / Managerul etc.**

In exercising its Governor / manager etc .:

- a) shows the Governing Council's annual activity report, the budget of revenues and expenses, annual financial statement, the budget of revenues and expenses and project programs department / body etc. he leads;
- b) legal agreements and on behalf of department / body etc. without offending and status of the federation;
- c) Governing Council proposed personnel policy department / body etc .;
- d) authorize any person, including persons who are not a member of the federation, to legal acts in the name and on behalf of the department / body etc. or to perform any other duties provided by statute or established by the Governing Council
- e) Governing Council Regulation proposes organization and functioning of the department / body etc .;
- f) Governing Council proposed organizational structure, duties and responsibilities of staff to .;
- g) perform any other duties established by the management or superior execution

**Note:** Governor / manager etc. He elected / appointed for a maximum period of four years, and if the work done is remunerated, in addition to the agreement Consiliului supreme or Senate General will undertake an exam to test competencies in the field and will be analyzing the work and experience.

## **ART. 22**

### **Activity of control**

The work of heritage management and control of financial and economic activity of the Federation is provided by at least one auditor elected by the Supreme Council / Senate General. If needed, the Supreme Council / Senate General may decide on setting up an auditing committee, called inspectorate, composed of at least three members, to take over control of the business federation duties. The inspector must be part of a federation member, appointed by the Supreme Council / Senate General, a lawyer and an accountant. Note: The lawyer will be replaced / fired if, following the advice or legal conflicts arise or if you lose more than 20% of legal disputes the federation is involved. Members of the Auditing Commission, if they are remunerated, will be subject to the provisions of the federation employees.

## **ART. 23**

### **The President**

President **EURO EDUCATION FEDERATION (EEF)** has the following responsibilities:

- a) represent the Federation in relations with third parties.
- b) coordinate the federation.
- c) lead and chair the Senate General Government Council / Supreme Council.
- d) perform any other duties established by the Senate General / Supreme Council.

Unless Federation president, vice exercise his powers.

Governing bodies, execution and control of the material federation responsible, civil and criminal law against the federation.

**23.1** detailed Powers of the management, execution and control of the legal representatives of the federation will be described in detail in the ROF.

## **ART. 24**

### **Secretary General**

Secretary General of the Federation drive current affairs under the guidance of the President.

## **ART. 25**

### **General Assembly decisions**

a) General Assembly decisions taken in compliance with the law and the statute are mandatory for all association members, even if they did not attend the meeting or voted against.

b) general assembly is led by the President, the Vice President, the Secretary General or, in their absence, by another member of the Board.

c) Decisions of the General Meeting of Members shall be taken by open vote, the vote of at least half plus one of those present, except those providing changes to the Statute, division, merger or dissolution, which required a majority plus one of the members of the federation.

d) The associate a certain issue subject to decision of the General Assembly is interested personally or through his spouse, ascendants or his descendants, relatives in collateral or related persons to the fourth degree, will not take part in the debates or vote. The associate who violates these provisions is liable for the damages caused by the federation, if without his vote would not have obtained the required majority.

e) Associations may, subject to the conditions of quorum and majority statutory for certain issues, decisions are taken by secret ballot.

f) the General Assembly shall be recorded in the minutes to be signed by the Board of federation.

g) General Assembly decisions contrary to the law, the Articles of Association or the provisions of the Statute can be challenged in court by one of the associations that did not take part in the General Assembly or voted against and asked to insert it into procesul- Minutes of the meeting within 15 days of the date when they are aware about the decision or the date when the meeting took place, as appropriate.

h) The request for cancellation shall be settled in the Council Chamber of the District Court within whose federation is established. The court decision is subject only to appeal.

## **ART. 26**

### **Powers of the General Assembly.**

- a. debate and approve the report of the Board of Directors of the Federation and the income and expenses;
- b. approves the strategy, objectives and program of the federal investment over the period to the next session of the General Assembly or longer periods;

- c. elect and dismiss the Board of Directors and the Audit Commission;
- d. elect the President;
- e. Choose Vice Presidents;
- f. Choose Secretary General;
- g. to decide on benefits and contributions will be subject associations;
- h. decide on the establishment or closing branches;
- i. decides on amendments heritage;
- j. decide on the merger, division, dissolution and liquidation of the federation, disposition of assets after liquidation;
- k. approve or amend the balance sheet and profit and loss account, after reviewing the reports of the Board of Directors and the Audit Committee;
- l. Approves insignia (emblem, badge, flag) and seals the federation;
- m. federation members in handling complaints about the decisions of the Board of Directors for admission or exclusion of the federation;
- n. a discharge to the Board of Directors;
- o. sets the emoluments of the President, Vice President, Secretary General, Board members and the Audit Committee.

#### **ART. 27**

##### **General Assembly decisions.**

General Assembly decisions are taken by simple majority, each member having the right to one vote. In the event of a tie, the president of the federation decides.

#### **ART. 28**

##### **Council director.**

In the interval between General Assemblies, association activity management is ensured by the Board as an executive body of the federation **EURO EDUCATION Federation (EEF) - CENTRE FOR HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT**, educational, artistic, cultural, sports and technology. The Board consists of 9 (nine) members elected by the General Assembly for a period of two (2) years.

The Council of Directors are: President, Vice Presidents, General Secretary and five members.

#### **ART. 29**

##### **Activities of Council Director.**

Activities of Council Director is coordinated by the Federation President who is also the President of the Board of Directors.

Council Director is responsible for the overall management of the federation, achieving the aim and object of its activity.

#### **ART. 30**

##### **Meetings of Council Director.**

Council Director shall hold its ordinary meeting once a month and extraordinary meetings whenever necessary.

#### **ART. 31**

##### **Prerogatives of Council Director.**

Council of directors ensures the execution of decisions of the General Assembly. In the exercise of its Board of Directors:

- a. Make the Federation in the interval between General Assemblies, seeks enforcement of the decisions of the General Assembly;

- b. administer and manage the Federation heritage and take decisions for management of funds;
- c. establish tactics and how to collaborate with other NGOs, local authorities and central government to achieve the objectives of the Federation;
- d. achievement of the rights and to enforce the obligations by associated members;
- e. examine the draft of revenue and expenditure, accounting balance sheet;
- f. subject to annual approval by the General Assembly no later than three (3) months from the date of conclusion of economic and financial activity report on the work of the Federation, balance sheet and profit and loss the previous year, and the draft program and project Budget of the Federation for the next year;
- g. approves the organizational structure, duties and responsibilities of personnel compartments Federation, approve the rules of organization and operation and applications for registration of new members and the General Assembly proposes withdrawal of membership;
- h. decide receipt and exclusion of members;
- i. presents the General Assembly's annual activity report, the budget of revenues and expenditures, annual financial statement, the budget revenue and expenditure and the draft federal programs;
- j. legal agreements and on behalf of the federation;
- k. authorize any person, including persons who are not a member of the federation, to legal acts in the name and on behalf federation or to perform any other duties provided by statute or by the General Assembly.
- l. decide whether the headquarters of the Federation.
- m. Other duties established by the General Assembly

#### **ART. 32**

##### **Meetings.**

The Council of Directors meets at the headquarters of the federation or in a location decided by mutual agreement or monthly meetings whenever necessary, convened by its President Audit Committee or at the request of 1/3 of the members of.

#### **ART. 33**

##### **Debates.**

The Council of Directors debates take place according to the agenda set based on the draft statement by the President at least five (5) days before. They shall be recorded in the minutes of the meeting are included in a special register.

#### **ART. 34**

##### **Decisions.**

The Council of Directors takes decisions by open vote. To validate decisions require the presence of at least half plus one of the Council of Directors members and decisions are taken by an absolute majority of the members present.

#### **ART. 35**

##### **Representation.**

In relations with third parties, the federation is represented by the President or the limits of the powers delegated to the Vice-President or Secretary General. Conducerea constant current operation and the Federation, in between meetings of the Board of Directors shall be chaired by the President and Secretary General.

#### **ART. 36**

##### **Activity of control.**

Activity heritage management control and financial-economic activity of the association is ensured by an auditor elected by the General Assembly. If necessary, the General Assembly may decide on setting up an auditing committee, composed of three members who will take charge of controlling the activity of the



federation. The auditing committee must include at least one member of the federation and a chartered accountant.

#### **ART. 37**

##### **President.**

President **EURO EDUCATION FEDERATION (EEF) - CENTRE FOR HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT**, educational, artistic, cultural, sports and technology has the following responsibilities:

- a. leads the General Assembly and the Board of Directors;
- b. reports and briefings on the work of the Board;
- c. represent the Federation in dealing with natural and legal persons, Romanian or foreign, with the authorities and courts of law;
- d. may delegate some of its powers, temporarily or permanently, Vice-President or Secretary General;
- e. sets tasks for Vice President, Secretary General and members and control how they are made;
- f. approves the Regulation of organization and functioning, working arrangements, work commissions and other regulations;
- g. convenes and chairs the General Assembly and Board members and propose issues will be the subject of the agenda;
- h. employing Federation heritage, within the competence established by the Board of Directors;
- i. organize concrete actions for achieving the purpose and objectives of the Federation;
- j. It acts to attract new members;
- k. performs other tasks set by the General Assembly and Board of Directors;

#### **ART. 38**

##### **Representation chairman of president.**

Where it is absent or is unable to perform his duties, the President is replaced by one of Vice determined by vote of the Board members.

#### **ART. 39**

##### **Coordination.**

President coordinates the implementation of projects and delegates Federation others to coordinate such projects.

#### **ART. 40**

##### **Legal interests.**

President coordinates the implementation of projects and delegates Federation others to coordinate such projects.

#### **ART. 41**

##### **Vicepresident.**

Vice President and Vice Chairman of the Federation is Director. He is elected by the General Assembly and meets, temporarily or permanently, some of the powers of the President. Follow the tasks set by the President and the Board of Directors. The legal substitute the President if he is absent or unable to perform his duties.

#### **ART. 42**

##### **General Secretary.**

The activity of forecasting, organization, analysis and operative management activity of the executive of the Federation and shall be chaired by the Secretary General, within the powers delegated by the President.

#### **ART. 43**

### **Secretary General Duties.**

Secretary General of the Federation responsible for its activity to the President and to the governing bodies of the organization and has the following responsibilities:

- a. coordinates the Federation's current financial administrative, performs all operations required for the fulfillment of the objects of the Federation, under the powers granted by the President;
  - b. a member of the Board of Directors with deliberative vote, and carry out the decisions of the Board of Directors and the General Assembly;
  - c. undertake Federation executive staff, organizational compliance and the number of positions approved by the President and Board of Directors establishes the duties and responsibilities of personnel;
  - d. respond to the Executive Council of the activities, decisions taken by the management of financial and material resources of the Federation has the right to sign financial transactions;
  - e. establishes the duties and responsibilities of operational staff compartments and the President;
  - f. prepare the draft annual work plan, organize concrete actions to achieve the goals and objectives of the federation;
  - g. proposed projects and organizational personnel structure of the federation;
  - h. Performing other tasks profile established by the General Assembly, Board of Directors and President;
  - i. shall act as a representation of the Federation within the powers delegated;
1. Keep your archives, as provided by law, federal records;

### **ART. 44**

#### **R.O.F.**

Detailed Powers of the Council of Director, President and Secretary General are determined by the Rules of Organization and Functioning (ROF).

### **ART. 45**

#### **Business.**

Secretary General of the Federation drive current affairs under the guidance of the President.

### **ART. 46**

#### **Responsibilities materials.**

Secretary General of the Federation responds material, civil and criminal law against the federation.

### **ART. 47**

#### **Social assistance.**

a) social solidarity that the whole community participates in supporting vulnerable people requiring support and social protection measures to overcome difficult situations or limitation in order to ensure social inclusion of this population;

b) subsidiarity, according to which, if the person or family can not ensure its full social needs, involved the local community and its associative structures and complementary State;

c) universality, that everyone has the right to social assistance, as provided by law;

d) respect for human dignity, that every person is guaranteed the free and full development of personality, his individual and social status are respected and the right to privacy and protection against any physical, mental, intellectual, political, or economic;

e) individual approach, that measures social life must be adapted to the particular situation of each individual; This principle takes into account the nature and cause of emergencies that may affect individual skills, physical and mental condition and the social integration of the individual; Individual support is addressed difficult situations including supportive measures addressed family members of the beneficiary;

f) partnership, under which the central and local public authorities, public and private institutions, NGOs, religious institutions recognized by law, and community members establish common goals, work together and mobilize all necessary resources to ensure decent and dignified living conditions for vulnerable people;

g) participation of beneficiaries, that beneficiaries participating in policy formulation and implementation with direct impact, to achieving individualized programs of social support and are actively involved in community life through forms of association or directly through voluntary activities carried out for persons Vulnerable;

h) transparency that ensures increasing the accountability of central and local government to citizens and fostering active participation of beneficiaries in decision-making;

- i) non-discrimination, that vulnerable people benefit from measures and actions for social protection without restriction or preference to race, nationality, ethnic origin, language, religion, social status, opinion, sex or sexual orientation, age, political affiliation, disability, contagious chronic disease, HIV infection or belonging to a disadvantaged category;
- j) the effectiveness, use of public resources that takes into account the objectives set for each activity and achieving the best results in relation to the planned;
- k) efficiency, that use of public resources is based on respect for the best cost-benefit ratio;
- l) respecting the right to self-determination, that everyone has the right to make their own choices, regardless of his social values, ensuring that it does not threaten the rights and legitimate interests of others;
- m) activation, that social assistance measures aim to encourage employment final for the purpose of integration / reintegration and increasing the quality of human life, and strengthen the family unit;
- n) the unique nature of the right to social assistance benefits, according to which the same needs or social risk can be awarded one benefit of the same type;
- o) proximity, that services are organized as close to the customer, to facilitate access and maintenance person as much as possible in their own living environment;
- p) complementarity and integrated approach, according to which, to ensure the full potential of social functioning of a person as a full member of the family, community and society, social services must relate to all the beneficiary's needs and provided integrated with a wide range of measures and services in the field economic, educational, health, cultural etc .;
- q) competition and competitiveness, according to which providers of public and private social services must be constantly preoccupied with increasing the quality of services provided and to receive equal treatment in the social services market;
- r) equal opportunities, that beneficiaries without any discrimination, have equal access to opportunities for personal fulfillment and development, but also social protection measures and actions;
- s) privacy that, for privacy, beneficiaries are entitled to confidentiality of personal data and information relating to privacy and the situation is difficult;
- t) fairness, that all people who have similar socioeconomic resources for the same kinds of needs, enjoy equal social rights;
- u) the focus, that social assistance benefits and social services addressing the most vulnerable people and is granted according to income and assets;
- v) The right to free choice of provider, according to which the beneficiary or legal representative has the right to freely choose between accredited suppliers.
- aa) accreditation is a process of certification of compliance by providers and social services provided criteria, indicators and quality standards for each type of service covered;
- bb) social investigation is an investigation method based on different techniques for collecting and processing information for the purpose of analyzing the social and economic development of individuals, families, groups or communities;
- cc) social assistance benefits are financial redistribution measures / material intended for individuals or families who meet the eligibility conditions prescribed by law;
- dd) the beneficiary is the person receiving social assistance benefits and / or, where appropriate, social services;
- ee) are members of the local community organizers of the local community, their forms of association, local government institutions and other public or private institutions and services of local interest;
- ff) contracting social services is the procedure of purchase / lease of social services, under a contract concluded under the law, by local government authorities;
- gg) deficiency is the consequence of loss or abnormality of body structure or of a physiological function;
- hh) disability is a generic term for impairments, activity limitations and participation restrictions in the context of the interaction between the individual who has a health condition and the contextual factors is contained or environmental factors and personal;
- ii) standard cost is the minimum required annual expenditure of social service provision, calculated for a beneficiary / types of social services, according to minimum quality standards and / or other criteria set by law. The current legislation is used as the minimum standard equivalent term cost;
- jj) community development is the process by which a community priority problems they identify, engage and cooperate in addressing them, using mostly domestic resources;
- kk) the residence is the address where the person resides says the main past and identity document of the person;
- ii) The social economy is a sector which includes economic activity which, alternatively, on condition of maintaining economic performance, include social object;

mm) eligibility is the set of prerequisites that must be met by potential beneficiaries to be selected in order to provide social assistance benefits and social services;

nn) hosting is to ensure that institutions providing social services and living conditions and rest for a period exceeding 24 hours;

oo) the household is the unit formed by several families and / or persons living together, jointly contribute to the acquisition or sale of property and income from their sale or their consumption;

pp) vulnerable group designates individuals or families who are at risk of losing their ability to meet the needs of daily living because of cases of disease, disability, poverty, drug or alcohol or other circumstances that lead to vulnerability economic and social;

qq) partial reduction or total incapacity is the possibility to perform a motor activity, cognition or behavior;

rr) disability is a Medico-legal concept that expresses the particular status of a person who has limited ability to work and insured in the public pension system and receive rights under the law;

ss) formal caregiver is the person qualified, certified professional who provides personal care or help to perform basic and instrumental activities of daily life by the person who lost operational autonomy;

ss') is the unskilled informal caregiver, family member, relative or any other person who provides personal care or help to perform basic and instrumental activities of daily life by the person who lost operational autonomy;

tt) housing means that live across administrative territorial unit without having a primary or secondary home;

tt') management is the management of social services by designated management and legal activities of material, human and financial service / institution / social assistance unit;

uu) case management is a method of coordination and integration of all activities for vulnerable groups, organization and management of social assistance measures specific, made by social workers and / or different specialists, in line with the objectives into action plans ;

vv) social environment is a whole life living conditions in the family and / or household, personal social relations, including the environment in which the person works, is educated and pursue their usual social activities;

ww) social need is indispensable to each person set of requirements to ensure the strict conditions necessary for life, ensuring social participation, as appropriate, social integration;

xx) special need is the set of requirements essential to ensure social integration of persons who, because of conditions of health, genetic or acquired during life, have a disability, and people who, for various reasons social, are disadvantaged personal development;

yy) individual assistance and care plan is drafted by a multidisciplinary team involving the beneficiary / her legal representative, which comprise the services provided to the recipient;

zz) Homelessness is a social group made up of single people or families who, for single or cumulative social, medical, financial, economic, legal or due to force majeure, living in the streets, temporary shelter with friends or known, is unable to support housing to be rented or are at risk of eviction, are in institutions or prisons from which it follows that, within two months, be discharged or released and have no home or residence;

aaa) people with disabilities are those who have physical, mental, intellectual or sensory impairments which in interaction with various barriers may hinder their full and effective participation in society on an equal basis with others;

bbb) are elderly people who have reached the age of 65;

ccc) for social inclusion comprise measures and multidimensional actions in the areas of social protection, employment, housing, education, health, information communication, mobility, security, justice and culture, to combat social exclusion and ensuring active participation people from all economic, social, cultural and political society;

ddd) is the process of social integration of the individual or group interaction and social environment through which equilibrium is functional parts;

eee) social protection is defined in the context of the principles, values and traditions that govern social relations between individuals, groups, communities and institutions in EU member states and represents a set of measures and actions aimed at ensuring a certain level of welfare and social security for the entire population and especially for particular social groups. Social protection consists of two components: contributory social security system and non-contributory social assistance;

fff) special protection of children is defined as the set of social security benefits and social services and programs, measures and action for the care and development of children deprived temporarily or permanently of parental care or a child who can not be left in their care to protect its interests;

ggg) is residing at that address individual claims to have secondary residences other than the home;

hhh) poverty is a state / a person / family / group / community manifested by lack of resources strictly necessary purchase of goods and services considered to ensure minimum living level in a certain period of time, based on socio-economic conditions of society. Poverty is quantifying the resources and standards used to make it are influenced by the general cost of living and the specific social policies adopted;

iii) community services as social services organized in a territorial-administrative unit organized as a commune, town, municipality and concern services provided at home and in day care centers and residential services addressed exclusively to citizens of administrative-territorial unit in question; They are similar to social services provided in the community;

jjj) difficult situation is where there is a person who, at some point during the life cycle of cause socioeconomic, health and / or which result from the social environment of life disadvantage, lost or limited own capacities for social integration; in difficulty may find families, groups of individuals and communities as a result of damage to the majority of their members;

kkk) civil society is composed of individuals associated in various forms on the basis of common interests, and who devote their time, knowledge and experience to promote and protect the rights and interests; associative forms can be mainly associations and foundations, unions and employers' organizations, cultural and religious organizations, community groups and informal;

iii) standard cost is the cost related minimum annual expenditure necessary for the provision of social services for a beneficiary calculated the types of social services, according to minimum quality standards and / or other criteria provided by law;

mmm) minimum quality standard is a set of criteria approved by mandatory national laws whose implementation provides a minimum acceptable level of performance of social service delivery process;

nnn) Community Task Forces is a joint formal or informal of local businessmen, priests, teachers, doctors, local counselors, policemen, other community members to support local authorities and social service providers in addressing the needs of community social services;

ooo) testing livelihoods of potential beneficiaries of social services is the procedure for assessment of revenues and movable and immovable property owned by the person or family in order to cover their consumption needs;

ppp) income all the amounts that the person or family members they make / receive as a result of paid employment, independent or agricultural, as defined by the Tax Code, the exploitation, use, disposal of property assets and those from the state social insurance rights, unemployment insurance, social assistance, legal maintenance obligations, other allowances, benefits and aid permanent or legal claims;

qqq) victim of trafficking is a natural, passive subject of acts of threat, violence or other forms of coercion, abduction, fraud, deception and abuse of authority, whether or not to participate in the proceedings as an injured party;

rrr) domestic violence refers to any physical or verbal misrepresentation by a family member against another member of the same family that causes physical, mental, sexual or material damage;

sss) Social assistance benefits in preventing and combating poverty and social exclusion risk are to provide funding to the minimum necessary daily living and supplementing income or means the person or family in question and the situation provided is based on testing of livelihood;

ttt) The main form of support for preventing and combating poverty and social exclusion risk is minimum income insertion granted from the state budget, community, social group or federation as the difference between the levels provided by special law and the net income of the family or single person made or received within a certain period of time in order to guarantee a minimum income of each person in the world;

uuu) main categories of social services aimed exclusively preventing and combating poverty and social exclusion are addressed risk individuals and families without income or low income, homeless, victims of trafficking and detainees;

vvv) Families and single persons with no income or low income can benefit from a wide range of social services tailored to individual needs, such as counseling and information services employability / social reintegration, rehabilitation services and the like;

zzz) social services for homeless aimed at ensuring the hosting period, associated with the granting of counseling and rehabilitation and social reintegration in accordance with individual needs identified;

## **ART. 48**

### **Heritage.**

The initial assets of **EURO EDUCATION FEDERATION (EEF)** is 700 RON, up by bank deposit.

Heritage association consists of:

a) fees, donations, funding, resources from the state budget and / or local budgets, membership, sponsorships, legacies, etc .;

- b) their economic activities to the extent that those are consistent with the purpose of the federation.
- c) creating businesses. Dividends obtained federation of the activities of these companies, if not reinvested in the same companies, are used to further the aim federation mandatory.
- d) Other revenues stipulated by law.

#### **ART. 49**

##### **The change of status.**

Changes to these Statutes require a majority of 100% of votes Supreme Council. This Statute was drafted in Romanian Supreme Council constitution adopted and enter into force on the date of its registration in the Register of Legal Persons of the County Court.

#### **ART. 50**

##### **Dissolution.**

The dissolution of the Federation shall require a majority of 90% of the votes of the Supreme Council. In case of dissolution, the assets and funds of the Federation come into patrimonial other associations, federations and institutions with the same or similar purpose and goals will be appointed by Senate General.
